supporting clients through their procurement processes for major capital projects, including prequalifications, RFP's, contractor evaluations, tenders, and contract negotiations.

You will assist clients to develop and establish project scope, budget, and schedule for major projects. Liaise with government agencies, regulatory bodies, Ministries, building inspection branches, and Fire departments to obtain design guidelines and approvals.

You will visit construction sites across Canada and the Caribbean to assess quality and progress of work, review and observe material and equipment testing inspections, establish deficiencies, conduct and supervise final inspections, ensure warranty inspections are performed and initiate action to correct, and ensure work is completed per contracts. Opportunities for extended construction supervision roles on sites in the Caribbean or across Canada may be available.

What do we need from you?

Our best fit for this position is an individual that has a minimum five (5) years' experience in project management of complex capital projects, with a background in building design and/or construction.
